COUNTY COMMISSIONERS' PROCEEDINGS Special Meeting

A special meeting of the County Commissioners of Logan County, Nebraska was held in the Commissioners' Room of the Courthouse in Stapleton, Nebraska. Notice of this meeting was given in advance thereof by publication in The Stapleton Enterprise in the issue dated February 27, 2020 and was simultaneously given to the Chairman all members of the County Board. Jacy Spencer, Ag Promotion Coordinator for the Department of Agriculture met with the board to promote having the County apply for a Livestock Friendly Designation. Livestock Friendly County Program is a voluntary program that recognizes counties that actively support and nurture the livestock friendly industry.

Jacy also talked to the board about the Nebraska Animal Feeding Operation Siting Matrix. The matrix was developed by a committee of livestock industry stakeholders under the direction of the Nebraska Department of Agriculture as guided by the Nebraska Legislature and LB106. The intent of the matrix is to provide a guiding framework for counties in developing consistent and defensible siting processes for animal feeding operations.
